

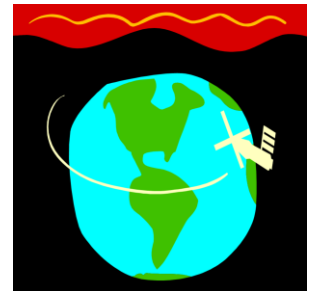


Kindergarten May 2012

MATH

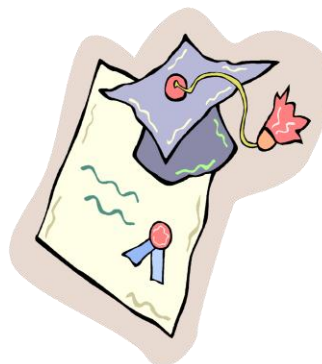
