Private Kindergarten Syllabus Everyday Math (University of Chicago)

Routines and Assessments:

Number line, student's journals, class routines, with calendar board, tally counts, number stories, and explorations

Everyday Uses of Numbers:

Numbers all around, numbers about me, clocks, time, coin recognition, and number stories

Visual Patterns and Number Patterns:

Visual patterns, odd and even number patterns, number line patterns, number grid puzzles and patterns, frames and arrow patterns, domino dot patterns and combinations

Thermometers, Linear Measures and Clocks:

Thermometer construction, linear measures, meter, centimeter measures, relationships of minute hand and hour hand, writing number grids

Relations, Number Stories, and Mental Arithmetic:
